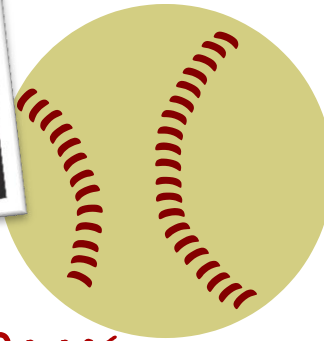

### Virginia Downes – *Mr. Chimney*

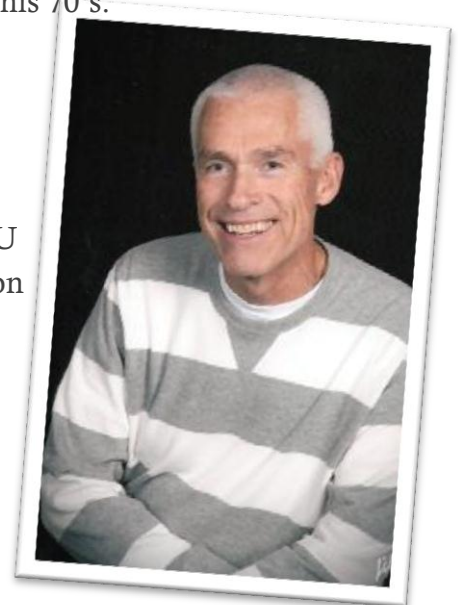
